

Gobblers going to city dinner tables

BRISTOL — The Human Resources Agency of New Britain distributed 60 turkeys to Bristol families in need Monday as part of an effort that saw 547 more given out at the HRA's five other locations.

Caren Dickman, communications and grant development specialist, said this year saw a very successful Thanksgiving turkey collection. Most were provided by Foodshare, but some came from private donors.

“Each year we seem to be getting more and more support,” she said. “We’ve been doing this since 2004 in New Britain and we came to Bristol in 2017, when we merged with the Bristol
